Crain's Chicago Business has worked with accounting firm Plante Moran to identify a list of companies that have established fastest growth in revenue since 2014. The ranking highlights the area's fastest-growing companies.

The list is made up of 50 companies and is featured online at www. chicagobusiness.com/2020fast50 and in Crain's print issue (published on Oct. 12). The 50 companies were selected based on the following eligibility criteria:

- Firms have been in business since at least Dec. 31, 2014
- Excludes real estate investment trusts, regulated banks, real estate developers, utilities, holding companies, subsidiaries/divisions, franchises and nonprofit organizations. Small companies were likewise not considered
- Companies had no more than one drop in revenue from 2014 to 2019

Combined, the businesses on this year's list grew revenue from \$3.9 billion in 2014 to \$12.6 billion in 2019, which translates to 225.5 percent growth.
